How to Enter & Eligibility

Nominations for the D.C. Lottery’s Gold Community Service Award. The award will be accepted through the agency’s official website at www.dclottery.com. Only online nominations will be accepted. Nominees must be 18 years or older, live or work in the District of Columbia and their service must also take place in the District of Columbia. Nominations will be accepted May 13, 2011 through August 3, 2012.

Selection

D.C. Lottery will select the winners, and they will be announced on or around the 15th of every month starting on June 15, 2011. One winner per month will be selected through August 2012. Details are included in the nomination rules.

Nomination Rules

Nominees must live or work in the District of Columbia and their “*Gold*” service must take place in the District of Columbia. D.C. Lottery staff will select the winner each month starting in June 2011. One winner will be selected per month, and the winners will be announced on or about the 15th of every month. Winners agree to be interviewed, photographed, videotaped, and promoted per the D.C. Lottery’s discretion and understand that the D.C. Lottery may use their image and or likeness and story or nomination for promotional purposes. No purchase is necessary. The D.C. Lottery reserves the right to make changes to the awards program at any time, including cancellation.
