POWERBALL[®] Nets Two \$10,000 Winners

Washington, D.C. –More than 9,000 D.C. Lottery players won a [POWERBALL](#) prize for the July 29 drawing, and Nathaniel Carter matched four white balls plus the red PowerBall to win \$10,000. And, he isn't the only one. A few days earlier, Kenneth Buraker also won \$10,000. He picked his lucky numbers for the July 25 drawing.

Both Carter and Buraker are Northwest, Washington, D.C. residents and each one found out that he had won by checking his numbers on the Internet.

Carter plans on saving his prize money for a few months because he wants to surprise his wife with a great gift. "I was pretty happy," said Carter, about his win.

A regular [D.C. Lottery](#) player, Carter said he always selects his own red PowerBall number. With this winning ticket, he selected eight as his PowerBall number because his father was born in August and used the Quick Pick option for the five white balls. He bought his winning ticket at Argonne Market, 1629 Columbia Road, N.W.

Buraker let the computer select all of his numbers. "I had forgotten that I had the ticket," he said. "I was coming back from lunch and pulled it out of my pocket, but I got busy at work and checked it at the end of the day." He said that when he finally saw the winning numbers, he was in disbelief. "You've got to be kidding me," Buraker laughed, adding that "I see an apple laptop in my future. My computer at home is old." He bought his ticket at Barmy's Liquor, 1912 L Street, N.W.
