It's True! Regular POWERBALL® Player Wins \$200,000

Washington, D.C. – “I felt like crying,” recalled Salamatu Koroma when happily reminiscing about the moment that a friend told her she had won \$200,000 with [POWERBALL](#). Koroma reacted to the news of her win by questioning her friend, “Are you telling me the truth?”

At the D.C. Lottery’s [Claim Center](#), Koroma’s initial disbelief was replaced with quiet excitement about her win. The Northeast, Washington, D.C. resident said she is going to save the money for her young daughter’s education. “That is most important right now.”

“Congratulations to Salamatu Koroma on winning \$200,000 with POWERBALL in the District of Columbia. We are excited to have another D.C. Lottery player win a big POWERBALL prize. Lots of People win with the D.C. Lottery,” said Buddy Roogow, executive director of the D.C. Lottery and Charitable Games Control Board.

To win \$200,000 for the May 26, 2010 POWERBALL drawing, Koroma correctly matched the five white balls: 1-6-10-13-20. She only missed one number, the red PowerBall number, which was 32. As a longtime POWERBALL player, Koroma said she always plays the same numbers. She bought her winning ticket at Takoma Park Liquors, 6200 Eastern Avenue, N.E.

The POWERBALL jackpot for Saturday’s drawing is \$44 million.
