## OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

PROMOTIONAL PERIOD: April 1, 2020 THROUGH November 20, 2020

## 1. CONTEST RULES.

A. These rules govern the Office of Lottery and Gaming's ("DC Lottery's") Radio One Scratcher 2nd Chance Contest ("Contest").
B. The Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic is evolving and modifications to these rules may be required. These changes have been amended to extend the Promotional Period and extending the Grand Prize Drawing Entry Submission Deadline and the Grand Prize Drawing Date.
C. By entering the Contest or by accepting a prize awarded through this Contest, each Contestant and Winner agrees to be bound by these rules.
D. This Contest is conducted by the DC Lottery. Urban One, Inc. D/B/A Radio One (Urban One) is not a sponsor of this Contest and is in no way responsible for administering this Contest.
2. PROMOTIONAL PERIOD. The Contest is scheduled to begin on April 1, 2020 at 12:01 a.m. (EDT) and end on November 20, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. (EST) ("Promotional Period").
3. ELIGIBLE ENTRIES. Contestants must be eighteen (18) years of age or older to participate in the Contest. Officers and employees of the DC Lottery and their relatives living in the same household, DC Lottery contractors, vendors, Urban One and its officers, directors and employees, and other persons who are otherwise disqualified, are not eligible for entry into this Contest. Tickets that have been discarded by the original purchaser are not eligible for entry into this Contest. Each entry must be completed on www.dclottery.com or on the official DC Lottery Second Chance Drawing Website. Each entry must include all required Contestant information including, but not limited to, Contestant's name, address, email address, and phone number, as well as the required code from each non-winning Radio One (Game No. 1449) scratcher ticket ("Qualifying Ticket"). Entries received after the Entry Submission Deadline will not be eligible for entry into the Contest. Contestants must make a qualified purchase in order to claim a prize. Entries must meet all eligibility requirements. Entries that are incomplete, garbled, corrupted, or unintelligible for any reason, including, but not limited to, computer or network malfunction or congestion (including, without limitation, at the DC Lottery's or any other entity's servers), are not eligible for entry into this Contest. Eligible Contestants may enter multiple times, subject to the entry requirements. Eligible Entries are only valid for the next drawing that occurs after entry into the Contest, except that all Eligible Entries will be included in the final Grand Prize Drawing. Persons

4. HOW TO ENTER. Every DC Lottery Radio One (Game No. 1449) scratcher ticket ("Ticket") will bear a ten (10) digit code under the scratch material at the bottom of the ticket front. During the Promotional Period, Contestants can use the ten (10) digit code to enter the Contest. Only nonwinning Qualifying Tickets can be used to enter the Contest. One (1) entry per Qualifying Ticket. Contestants enter the Contest by going to www.dclottery.com or the official DC Lottery Second Chance Drawing Website (secondchance.dclottery.com) and entering all required Contestant information and the required ten (10) digit code from a Qualifying Ticket. All entries must be received by the DC Lottery before the Entry Submission Deadline dates and times listed in the chart below. Contestants are not required to save their Qualifying Tickets once they are entered into the Contest.

A. Potential Winners. The first three (3) Eligible Entries drawn in drawings one (1) and drawings five (5) through fourteen (14) shall be the Potential Winner of the prize package for that drawing. The first four (4) Eligible Entries drawn in drawings two (2) through five (5) shall be the Potential Winner of the prize package for that drawing. The first Eligible Entry in drawing fifteen (15) shall be the Potential Winner of the prize package for the Grand Prize Drawing.

C. Winner Notification Letters and Acceptable Forms of ID. Winner Notification Letters include a copy of these Official Contest Rules and information about how to claim the prize. The notification letter an Acceptance and Release Form that must be fully completed and signed and included with the mailed in prize claim. Potential Winners must also include copies of two (2) forms of identification in their mailed in prize claim in order to claim a prize. Acceptable forms of identification include: (a) a valid state issued Driver's License, or state issued Non-Driver's License, or a valid Passport and (b) an original Social Security card. 9. ACCEPTANCE AND RELEASE FORM. Potential Winners, proxies and their guests must sign the DC Lottery's Acceptance and Release Form. The Acceptance and Release Form confirms the Potential Winner's compliance with these Official Contest Rules and other requirements. In addition, by signing the Acceptance and Release form, Potential Winners authorize the DC Lottery, without any further consideration, to use the Potential Winner's likeness and name, and the Potential Winner's city, county, and state of residence for advertising, reporting, and promotional purposes in any print, broadcast, electronic, internet, or other form or media whatsoever. Potential Winners also release the Contest Entities and their representatives from liability of any kind and from any claims arising out of this Contest or prizes awarded.
10. PRIZES AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS. Odds of winning any prize depend on the number of entries received for each drawing. The DC Lottery reserves the right to substitute prizes. A prize is not transferable once the winner has claimed. Winnings valued at more than $\$ 600$ will be reported to federal, state and District tax agencies.
11. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY. All decisions regarding the Contest including, without limitation, winner selection, disposition of a prize, payment of taxes, selection of alternates, photograph suitability for public display, application and interpretation of the Official Contest Rules, resolution of any dispute or Contest eligibility shall rest solely with the Executive Director of the DC Lottery ("Executive Director") or the Executive Director's designee and shall not be subject to appeal. The Executive Director may change the date, time and location of Drawings. The Contest is subject to cancellation at any time. The Executive Director reserves the right to change and supersede any outlined procedures or rules to handle unforeseen circumstances. The Contest Entities are not responsible or liable for entries or notifications and required documents that are not otherwise in compliance with these Official Contest Rules, whether caused by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest, or by any technical or human error which may occur in the processing of Eligible Entries into the Contest, or for failure to receive Eligible Entries due to transmission failures or technical failures of any kind and such noncompliant entries will be disqualified. 12. GOVERNING LAW AND VENUE. This Contest shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws and regulations of the District of Columbia. Venue shall be in an appropriate court of jurisdiction located in the District of Columbia.
13. ENTRIES TO REMAIN THE PROPERTY OF THE DC LOTTERY. All entries shall remain the property of DC Lottery and may be destroyed. No entries will be returned to Contestants.
